This course is a continuation of the Basic Keelboat Sailing Certification program. Each lesson is 100% on the water out in San Francisco Bay's famous big breeze! Classes are held aboard our amazing J/70, J/80 & SC27 keelboats. Basic Coastal Cruising is for national certification by the American Sailing Association.

Students should bring foul weather gear (at least a waterproof jacket) and wear deck boots, tennis or deck shoes (no black soles please).

We will be sailing in the Slot and you will get wet on the way to/from Angel Island. Upon Graduation ASA 118-A is pre-requisite prior to doing your first bareboat charter.

Basic Coastal Cruising Schedule

Basic Coastal Cruising is offered several ways to accommodate students varying schedules.

Midweek

Accelerated Schedule

3 Days in a row -

Classes start the 2nd & 4th weeks of each month Mon - Weds 11:00 am - 5:00 pm



Weekend

Accelerated Schedule

2 Days per weekend (Saturday and Sunday in the same Weekend for 2 consecutive weekends)

Classes start the 1st & 3rd weekends of the month as they run two consecutive weekends.

Sat & Sun 11:00 am - 4:00 pm

Basic Sailing 2 (ASA-101) is a prerequisite for Basic Coastal Cruising (ASA-103). You need to pass ASA 118a Docking prior to being eligible to bareboat charter. Once passed you can charter boats in our fleet up to 27' Your first 5 charters must be South of the Bay Bridge. Bridge then 3 more charters in the middle Bay to meet the pre-requisites for Intermediate Coastal Cruising**
