WHAT TO BRING

(On Your Cruise)

So that you will have a most enjoyable cruise, please read the following important information:

- Weather and sailing conditions can vary substantially from hour to hour, therefore, it is very important to be prepared!
- Bring clothing that can be put on in layers. (And bring plenty of them!) Make sure that you have a good waterproof coat, poncho, or other protective gear. Since we will be sailing, we do occasionally take a little spray over the bow!
- -Sunscreen, sunglasses and possibly a hat are highly recommended at all times during daylight hours.
- -Footwear should be comfortable, with light colored soles.
- -If the weather is a little overcast or drizzly in the morning on the day you plan to sail with us, don't worry! The weather tends to clear up in the early afternoon for a gorgeous day of sailing!

There is no public parking on the Pier 40 lot. Refer to the many parking options on the back of this flyer.

Footwear should be comfortable, with light colored soles. Topsiders or sneakers are ideal. No highheels No black soled or street shoes please! These mark the decks.

Please note: Pier 40 is not located next to Pier 39. All odd numbered piers are north of the Bay Bridge. Pier 40 is south of the Bay Bridge next to Oracle Ballpark, (formerly AT&T) where the SF Giants play.

DIRECTIONS TO SOUTH BEACH HARBOR

REMEMBER. Baseball Days will be VERY congested in and around the harbor. Call us for the schedule and "clear traffic" times. Generally expect heavy traffic 1 hour prior and 1 hour post game and very light traffic during the game

FROM THE EAST BAY - Take the Bay Bridge into the City. Stay in the left lane and take the first S.F. exit, "Harrison St./Embarcadero" (note; left hand exit), turn right at Harrison, Follow to Embarcadero, turn right. Head about 1/2 mile South to Pier 40.

FROM THE PENINSULA - Take US 101 North. About 1 mile north of Candlestick Point, take the "280 North - Port of San Francisco" exit. Follow 280 to the last offramp (King Street). King turns into Embarcadero. Go up about 1/2 mile to Pier 40, at the intersection of Townsend and Embarcadero.

FROM SAN FRANCISCO - Take Embarcadero South along the Waterfront. South Beach Harbor is located at the intersection of Townsend and Embarcadero on Pier 40, 1/2 mile South of the Bay Bridge.

FROM MARIN COUNTY - Take US 101 South across the Golden Gate Bridge. Take the Marina exit. Follow the waterfront to Bay Rd., turn left. Head East on Bay to the end, turn right on Embarcadero. Head South on Embarcadero past the Bay Bridge to Pier 40.

PARKING INFORMATION

There is no parking in the South Beach Harbor lot as it's for tenants only. There are 5,000 spaces withing 10 minutes walk. There's huge lots on Pier 30/32, also at Main & Embarcadero. There's many indoor lots on Townsend between 2nd & 3rd. There's smartmeter parking all along the Embarcadero with no time limit.

PUBLIC TRANSIT INFORMATION

FROM THE EAST BAY:

Take BART to the first San Francisco station Embarcadero. Walk up one level to MUNI and take the N-Line South. Get off at either Brannan or Second street station and walk to Pier 40 (about 3 minutes). You can also walk from BART heading south down the Embarcadero along the waterfront promenade (15-25 minutes).

FROM THE PENINSULA:

Take CalTrain to the last station, Fourth & Townsend. Walk up King or Townsend streets to Pier 40, South Beach Harbor.

FROM SAN FRANCISCO:

Muni Buses- Take the #32 (Embarcadero) or the #42 Muni Rail- E Line (from Fisherman's Wharf) N Line (from Market st./BART)

FROM MARIN COUNTY:

Take Golden Gate Transit (either boat or bus). The ferry is great and it's a lovely 15 minute walk down the Embarcadero Promenade to Pier 40 from the Ferry Terminal
